Section C

ACQUIRING MOVEMENT SKILLS

The average mark for this section was 12.5.

Question 1

- a) Most candidates were not accurate in answering of this question.
- b) Despite many general sports could develop proprioception, most answers were vague and few candidates were specific in their answers.
- c) Generally answered correctly.
- d) Generally answered correctly.

Question 2

- a) Generally answered correctly.
- b) A wide variety of incorrect answers.
- c) The definition of response time was mostly answered incorrectly.
- d) Answers included improvement of general reaction time and were not specific to response time.

Question 3

- a) Most answers were inaccurate.
- b) Despite some good answers, there were candidates who gave the exact situation as the question itself.
- c) Generally answered correctly.

Section D

SOCIO-CULTURAL STUDIES

The average mark for this section was 9.

Question 1

- a) Generally answered correctly.
- b) Generally answered correctly. Some incorrect answers referred to swimming as the first sport.
- c) Some candidates gave the incorrect city or year.

- d) Many candidates knew what sportsmanship was but could not distinguish it from gamesmanship. Some did not attempt to define gamesmanship.
- e) Few answers were specific to surfing and karate but the majority of candidates gave a satisfactory answer.

Question 2

- a) Most answers had a basic recollection but were not accurate in covering all aspects of the objectives.
- b) Despite many correct answers, some answers where not specific to swimming but to the general limitations of all athletes in Malta.
- c) Generally answered correctly.
- d) Generally answered correctly.

Question 3

- a) The vast majority of answers were incorrect.
- b) Generally answered correctly.
- c) Few answers recalled a full definition. Most answers included the promotion of football but missed the importance of fighting discrimination.
- d) Some candidates did not answer this question but the ones who did provided a correct response.
- e) Few answered correctly.
