## **Self-Employed Students**

In terms of Regulation 4(e) and 10 of Legal Notice 308 of 2016, self-employed students can only be considered as eligible for the maintenance grants if they are working on a part-time basis. Students who are registered as full-time self-employed cannot be deemed as eligible, and their application will be discarded accordingly.
