Introduction

- The COFUND is the result of a collaboration between JPI Oceans and the former ERA-NETs COFASP (2012-2017) and ERA MBT (2012-2017) and consists of 32 partners from 17 European countries.
- The main objective of the COFUND is to establish a coordinated R&D funding scheme that will strengthen Europe's position in the blue bioeconomy.







Figure 1. Blue Bioeconomy R&I areas along the value chains from biomass to products and markets, showing crosscutting R&I areas in lower part of the figure.






Figure 3. Blue Bioeconomy Value Chain with gaps in R&I identified for this call

PRIMA S2 Call for Proposals

Call Details Consortium composition:

at least 3 entities from 3 different Participating States of which:

- at least one must be established in an EU Member State participating in PRIMA: Cyprus, Croatia, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Luxembourg, Malta, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain;
- at least one must be established in a Non-EU country participating in PRIMA: Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Tunisia, Turkey.

Duration (max.): 36 months

National Budget: € 500 000

Introduction


