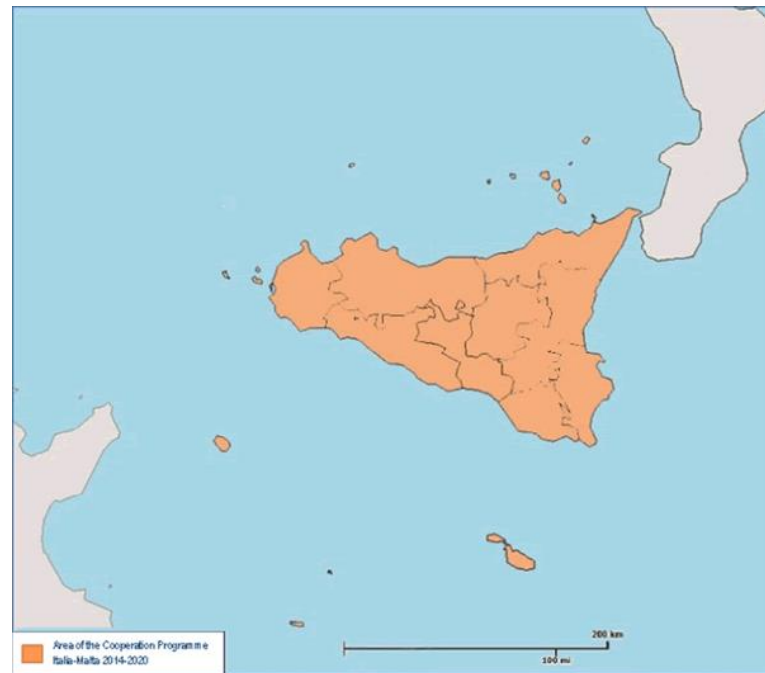


Overall Objective

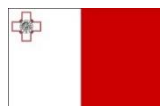
