TO ALL STUDENTS

According to the provisions of Regulation 25 and 26 (1) of the General Regulations for University Postgraduate Awards, 2021, two students are to be elected by and from among the students enrolled on the Master of Arts in Cultural Heritage Management. In accordance with Regulation 23 of the General Regulations for University Postgraduate Awards, 2021, the term of office is of one year. At present there are vacancies for two student representatives on this Board of Studies.

Nominations, on forms available from the Faculty website or the Faculty Office, are to be handed in at the Faculty Office, Room 205, **by noon of Thursday 27th November 2025.**

Nominations are to be duly proposed and seconded by enrolled students. Nominated students are required to signify, in writing, acceptance of their nomination.

Nominations will be published on the Faculty Office Notice Board on **Monday 1st December 2025** and all students will be informed of this by email.

Eligibility to vote: Students may verify whether they are eligible to be nominated and to vote on this Board of Studies at the Faculty Office.

Voting will take place by secret ballot on **Thursday 4th December 2025** from 09:00 to 12:00 at the Faculty Office, Room 205, Level 1, Built Environment Building.
