COURSE OVERVIEW

The MTL is a course which enables graduates to teach at primary and secondary level, according to the area of specialisation chosen.

MTL IN BUSINESS EDUCATION

You embark on this course to become fully qualified to teach accounting, business studies and economics. You shall be provided with the opportunity to interact with lecturers who have extensive experience in teaching these subjects, who promote interactive teaching and learning strategies, and encourage a collaborative ethos.

Course requirements

A first-cycle degree with at least 16 ECTS credits in Accountancy, 16 ECTS credits in Economics, and 38 ECTS credits in areas considered relevant by the Board of Studies.

Note: If you do not possess the full compliment of credits required and need to obtain 12 ECTS credits or less, you are allowed to register for the course on the condition that these credits are obtained during the MTL course.

MTL IN RETAIL

You embark on this course to become a fully qualified teacher of VET Retail.

Course requirements

A first cycle degree with at least 70 ECTS credits in a relevant area of study.
