**NUR4427 Water EDUCare: Pharmaceutical Pollution Awareness for Healthcare Professionals
4 ECTS Credits**

Available for: This micro-credential is intended for clinicians and healthcare professionals seeking to enhance their knowledge and competencies in addressing pharmaceutical pollution, particularly antibiotic residues, within healthcare settings. Qualified nurses who hold an EQF Level 5 qualification and are registered as first-level nurses with the Council for Nurses and Midwives or with a regulatory body recognised by the University of Malta are eligible to register and attend the course.

Practising health care professionals who are interested in enrolling on these study-units are invited to apply by **Thursday, 30 April 2026. (Deadline Extended to 10 May 2026)**

Applicants must submit their application as new users. A unique username and password must be created specifically for this application, and credentials used in previous University of Malta applications must not be reused. When prompted, applicants should select Visiting Student (1/F) – 2025/6 from the drop-down menu. Applications are considered complete only when the Submit button is clicked at the end of the application process, upon which a confirmation receipt will be sent automatically to the applicant's personal email address.

- It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure that the application is submitted by the deadline indicated above.
- Commencement of the study-units is subject to the:
 - availability of resources at the time of opening
 - number of qualified applicants

The Faculty of Health Sciences shall attempt to announce the days on which a study-unit is to be held prior to its commencement. However, it cannot be bound by fixed days and times for the duration of the study-unit/s.
