

Preparatory Course for the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Nursing October 2023

Academic Proficiency Test

Applicants seeking to join the Preparatory Course for the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Nursing in terms of Regulation 6 (c) of the *Admissions Regulations*, 2016, and who would have reached the age of 23 by the beginning of the course (ie: by the 1 October 2023), are required to sit for an academic proficiency test.

The test will include three sections including multiple choice questions focusing on English Language, Mathematics and General Science respectively. It is one and a half hours long. Each section will include 30 multiple choice questions. The term 'general science' refers to basic chemistry and biology at school leaving level. A pass (45%) in each section is required for applicants to be admitted to the course.

The academic proficiency test will be held on **Tuesday 12 September 2023 at 10.00am.** Further information will be communicated to applicants considered in terms of the above mentioned clause in due course.

Applicants who are applying for admission in terms of the above regulation will be contacted by the Faculty and informed of the test in writing.
