Applicants are requested to submit a scanned copy of references/attestations providing evidence of gainful employment in a work setting relevant to the area of study to Ms Charmaine Buttigieg (Programme Secretary) at the following email address **by not later than the 31 August 2026**:

References/attestations should be printed on an official letterhead of the organisation/entity concerned and should include the date of commencement of employment/experience (and of termination – if applicable), and the designation and contact details of the employer/referee who has signed the letter.

References/attestations which do not include the requested details specified above will not be considered.

*In courses where a limited number of students is indicated, applicants who are fully qualified by the 31 August 2026 (**including having submitted the above mentioned documents to the Faculty**) will be considered first and will be placed in rank order. If, after this initial ranking, vacant places are still available, and if applicants would have obtained the necessary qualifications and submitted the above documents by the 30 September 2026, they will then be placed in rank order to take up any remaining places.*

The Selection Board reserves the right to consider, under the Policy for the Recognition and Accreditation of Prior Learning (RPL), applicants who do not satisfy the standard entry requirements, provided that they can demonstrate sufficient and relevant qualifications and experience. Applicants shall also be **required to present evidence of a professional licence or warrant in their respective field**, confirming their suitability to undertake this course of study.
