Students undertaking work in the laboratories and/or using other departmental facilities should consult the University Health and Safety Guidelines that may be downloaded from: http://www.um.edu.mt/hrmd/services/healthsafety

In particular, students who would like to work in the laboratories and/or use other facilities of the Department of Biology should note the following:

- (i) Undergraduate students are **not** allowed to work in the laboratories and/or use other facilities of the Department of Biology **outside normal work hours**. If any undergraduate student requires to work outside normal work hours, the need for this should first be discussed with his/her supervisor.
- (ii) Postgraduate students should ideally **avoid** working in the laboratories and/or use other facilities of the Department of Biology **outside normal work hours**.

In either of the above, if a student and his/her supervisor feel that such after hours work is crucial, then an official request for permission should be sent to the Head of Department for evaluation. The Head of Department will then discuss the request with the supervisor and H&S Officer, and a decision for granting/not granting permission taken. If permission is granted, the student may be required to follow a given procedure to ensure health and safety considerations.
