



SOR Undergraduate Dissertation Overleaf Template: Setup and Usage Instructions

In the downloaded zipped folder, kindly find the Overleaf Template.

To use it, press on New Project on the Overleaf Homepage, and click on Upload Project, then drag the attached zip file. The template contains some simple examples to explain how to use it.

It is very important that once the project has been imported, all the files are removed from the folder 'thesis_template' (on the file manager pane of the editor) and are in the root directory of Overleaf (otherwise the Glossaries and Acronyms won't work):
