#### Developing a Draft Programme of Studies during your mobility.

This exercise is meant to support you in drafting a programme of studies during your mobility. Carry out this exercise for each university that you are listing as a preference. This is important so that you can check that all the universities that you are listing as a preference will have the study units that you need to find replacements for, that these modules are on offer during your mobility semester and that the language of tuition for these modules is in English.

Please keep in mind that you might not be selected for any of your preferred universities as placements will be allocated at a later stage.

It is your responsibility to make sure that when you are preparing your draft programme of studies, you do not repeat any study units that you have already followed in your first year or that you will follow in your third year. Repeated modules in your course programme might hinder you from graduating.

#### Please refer to the table below:

- On the left-hand side, list the UM compulsory and optional study units you would have taken at UM during your mobility semester. (B.A. Year 2, Sem 1; B. Psy Year 2 Sem 2)
- On the right-hand side,
  - Write the name of the Host university
  - List the equivalent modules you will take during your mobility and fill in the relevant information: Host University Study-Unit Code, Host University Study-Unit Title, Host University Study Unit Link, Host University Study Unit Description
- If you do not find matches for the compulsory units, please write in the notes column when you plan to take the module at UM (e.g. Year 3 or Year 2 Sem 1 in the case of PSY3647 Selected Topics in Organisational Psychology)
- If you do not find matches for the elective units at UM, list other electives that you will take instead at the host university.
- Keep in mind that you will need to find around 30 ECTS credits. (Total for the year is at minimum 60 ECTS and it cannot exceed 64 ECTS).
- Do this process for each of the 3 to 5 host universities that you will submit as preferences.

It is good practice when sending Erasmus documents to **always put the date in the file name** since you might be preparing different versions of the same document.
