

You need to send a CV and a motivation letter.

Your **CV** lists your work and qualifications. You may also send evidence of relevant qualifications (certificates, etc.) Some examples of these are listed on the last page of this document.

The **motivation letter** says why you want to do this course. You do not have to write a letter. You can send a link to a video in LSM. Information about this is also on the last page of this document.

Documents to be submitted

- Curriculum Vitae (C.V.) and Motivation Letter

Applicants in terms of the 'maturity (adult learners) clause' of the Admission Regulations are required to send a soft copy of their Curriculum Vitae (C.V.) together with a letter addressed to the Faculty Admissions Committee giving your motivation for applying for this course. These documents should be sent to linguistics@um.edu.mt within one week of submitting this application.

2. Payment.

Before **23 July 2025 at 2pm**, the application fee is **€23** for people with local qualifications.

After 23 July, the fee is €60. You can apply until 15 September 2025 at 2pm.

If you do not pay, we will not receive your application. You will receive a confirmation email when you have submitted your application.

- A lecturer from the Institute of Linguistics & Language Technology
- Two LSM interpreters
- A foreign lecturer who has experience in teaching sign languages

You will also have a chance to ask questions about the course.
