The Maltese Legal System, Volume II, Part A, entitled Constitutional and Human Rights Law, deals with the characteristics of the Maltese Constitution, the constitutional doctrines of the separation of powers, the rule of law, and the supremacy of the Constitution over parliament.

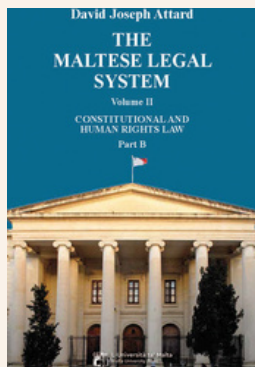
It discusses the constitutional development of Malta until it finally attained the status of an independent state together with the authority of the Maltese Constitution. The monograph studies the main features of the Maltese Constitution and its sources.

The main state organs and offices established by the Constitution are analysed and first hand evidence on the operation of these organs and offices through state practice is provided.

The publication focuses upon the judiciary, the doctrine of the independence of the judiciary, and their watchdog – the Commission for the Administration of Justice.

Other matters dealt with are the cumbersome procedure to alter the Constitution and the various electoral systems prevalent in Malta with special focus on that relating to the election of MPs, their respective electoral process and the main protagonists in elections – political parties and their financing. Linked to elections are popular referenda that are also referred to.

Other sections introspects recent constitutional amendments that were ongoing or being concluded when this work was being finished and foreign influence on Maltese Law.[]It also contains an introductory chapter on human rights that is further developed in Volume II, Part B.

In *The Maltese Legal System, Volume II, Part B*, Professor David Joseph Attard creates a portrait, a snapshot, of the Maltese legal system. Indeed, it is an entire volume dedicated to salient human rights and fundamental freedoms' case law. The author does not restrict himself only to local constitutional law and rights, but goes beyond that, into the European Convention on Human Rights and the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights. Little, if anything, seems to escape the attention and scrutiny of this eminent scholar. One cannot but not notice the painstaking attention to detail. This starts with the division, between protection of human rights in Malta, and the protection of fundamental freedoms in Malta.

The author lists first the protected human rights and, afterwards, the protected fundamental freedoms. He delves through them one by one, first describing the provision and adding any necessary comments pertinent to their understanding, arranging the chosen court judgments under each article.

The author studied the case law in great depth, managed to extract the important issues, and classified the court judgments accordingly. He builds his write up on the particular case, on the particular issue which caught his attention, on what is the salient point. This seminal volume is seamlessly put together and the principles and the references flow from one to the next. It is not simply a list of ad hoc principles extracted from court judgments, but the fruit of an in depth understanding and scholarly work.

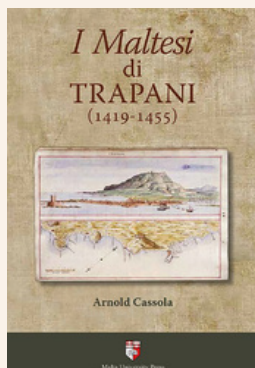
Roberto Ranieri Costaguti lived through one of Italy's most turbulent periods, experiencing political, religious and social movements. Mgr. Costaguti was one of the most gifted homilists of his time. His reputation among his contemporaries, as a talented and erudite preacher, whose delivery was often direct and eloquent, attracted many invitations to preach at various places in Italy and abroad. Costaguti had also been repeatedly requested to preach in Malta. He must have impressed Grandmaster Pinto because the latter had no hesitation in appointing him Rector of his newly founded University. His stay in Malta as Rector was a brief but fruitful one. He thus played a pivotal role in shaping Malta's educational institutions. Soon after his return to Italy, following the termination of his appointment as Rector, Roberto Costaguti was consecrated Bishop of Sansepolcro. This Tuscan bishop later witnessed the Italian campaigns of the French Revolutionary Wars (1792-1802) which saw the invasion and occupation of the Italian States, including the Papal ones, by Napoleon. He learnt of the arrest of Pope Pius VI, who died in exile in France in 1799. During the French interregnum he, at times, stood his ground and even refused to accept the Legion d'Honneur offered to him by the French Emperor.

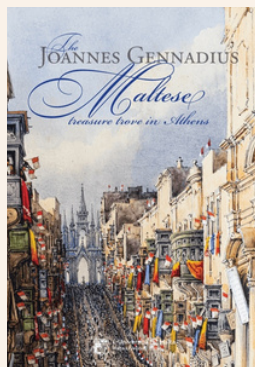

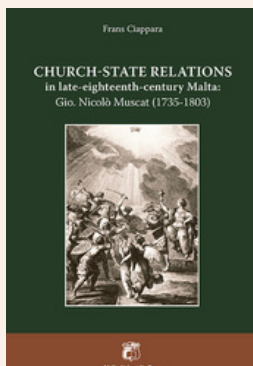

This visionary, passionate in his hatreds, who with his savage comments and rigid character rarely blended prudence with courage, and whose mind was so sorely swept by the winds of controversy, would be proved right in embracing the cause of the separation between Church and State and distinguishing canon from civil law. His ideas gained ascendancy after his death; they were destined to survive him and become visions in the soul of future generations. The credit they deserved was long overdue. The Erasmian seeds of his ideas which he expressed during the struggle were sown in the hearts of his compatriots. They fell neither 'beside the path, so that all the birds came and ate them up', nor on rocky land and among the briars but 'where the soil was good, and these yielded a harvest.' As the papers selected for publication in these proceedings amply demonstrate, the discussion encompasses disciplines right across the spectrum of scholarship – from archaeology to philosophy, history to governance, the arts and the sciences. Above all, perhaps, it evokes and portrays the spirit of free enquiry, the cutting edges of engagement, dialogue and discourse, the shared heritage of which has perhaps most singularly shaped a European mind and identity in its multiple and changing forms, genres and varieties. Speakers and discussants explored the realms of ethics and freedom, of politics and society, of culture from the humanistic to the cosmopolitan, including technology and communications.
