Payment Procedure for the Kids on Campus Summer School

This procedure delineates the payment process for applicants of the Kids on Campus Summer School, provided by the Child Educare Services at the University of Malta. This service operates on the University of Malta Campus.

Applications

Applications for the KOC Summer School become available online on Easter Monday. Upon submission of an application, the applicant will be prompted to complete the payment online. Payment for the program, as well as for any additional supervised time between 07:00 and 07:30 or 13:30 and 14:00, must be settled in advance. This additional supervised time comes at a cost of €40 for the morning extra time and €40 for the afternoon extra time, for the entire summer.

Registration Form A (UM Employees who are Council appointed and who work a minimum of 20 hours per week)

Registration Form B (General Public)

5-day week first child	€420
5-day week siblings (p/c)	€400

Absent Days

Ideally, we request information about any planned days of absence, which are non-

transferrable for children attending 3 days per week.

Extra Supervised Hours

Extra supervised hours can be booked as a package either for the morning, from 07:00 to

07:30, or for the afternoon, from 13:30 to 14:00.

These hours can be purchased alongside the online application at a rate of €40 for each

respective time slot. Applicants have the option to purchase either the morning or the

afternoon slot, or both, with payment coering the entire summer period.

Other Considerations

Transport to and from the summer school is a separate cost from other summer school

expenses, as per the agreement with the transport serivce provider. Transport is available to

and from the University Campus and must be settled with the third-party provider.

Any fees related to outing venues and transportation will be communicated once the program

commences and must be settled with the child's teacher promptly.
