Research Profile

Savvas' research interests are mainly energy and energy conservation and reduction of the environmental impacts of buildings and various energy processes.



In recent years this has concentrated mainly on the food industry and the environmental impacts and the CO2 omissions from the food industry in the UK.

The food chain in the UK is responsible for 14% of the total energy consumption and specifically the supermarkets are responsible for 3% to 5% of the electrical energy consumption and about 1% of the CO2 omissions in the UK.

When shopping in a supermarket many freezers do not use any doors so as to increase sales. A lot of air spills out of the cabinet into the aisle of the supermarket so your feet when you go into the supermarket in the summer get quite cold.

We try to protect the products from the ambient conditions by having this invisible air curtain in front of the cabinet
